## DUKE DID IT: 741 m.p.h.

Sqr-Ldr. Neville Duke was all set at Tangmere for his world-speed-record bid. On four runs of the 3-kilometre course he had to better the existing record by 1%. He averaged 722 miles-an-hour,

only to learn that even that mightn't be enough - by a fraction of one mile an hour. But on two runs Duke flew faster than anyone else in the world.

Twice he touched 741 m.p.h.

The other two runs were 704 and 703, average 722
