#1. Papho District sign. Tents have been given to the homeless people of KTIMA town. Navy at work for placing the tents and other help. Several shots of the victims in temts camped near the town KTIMA.

12. More shots of the Royal Navy helping the homeless people. (till the 50th feetage I belive will be O.K. the rest I think is speiled but more shots are continued to roll M3.)

Rell. 3. A Cyprus Policeman stationed at the Capital NICOSIA, heard that his family was killed he arrived paphos and find them all safe in tents given by the Government. Other shots of different housed ruined.

Roll 2.4. More victims are still with put any tents, and are staying open after they make tents with blankets. The shot showing children in such tent are children of two families whose fathers have been killed, and are camping near their ruin houses. Next shots are navy from the H.M.S. SAINTES and the aircraft carrier THESEUS, and are going to town, KTIMA.

Roll. #5. shots of the ships in harbur. From H.M.S. THESEUS shots are taken showing the helicopter of the ship and background the destroyer.
