


Airborne Commemoration at Arnhem.

On the 17th of September 1944 Airborne troops landed at Arnhem on the river Rhine in the Eastern part of Holland. Every year, on the anniversary of their landing, their heroic fight is commemorated by the Arnhem population. Every year also there is an Airborne pilgrimage to Arnhem of British relatives of the deceased and of veterans who survived the ferocious battle.




This year a monument was unveiled by H.M. Queen Juliana, in honour of the soldiers who gave their lives in the struggle for the liberation.

The monument was made by the Arnhem sculptor Gijsbert Jacobs van den Hof, by order of the municipality of the town.

The statue is placed before the Great Church which was partly destroyed during the battle and of which rebuilding is in progress.

Leader of the Pilgrimage was General R.E. Urquhart, Commander of the 1st British Airborne division, who led the battle of Arnhem.
