KOREA FIRST PICTURES RED PILOT WHO DELIVERED MIG

The Russian-built MIG 15, air arm of North Korea -- for which a reward of \$100,000 was offered by the UN Commander. And one is delivered-by a 22-year-old Red Korean Lieutenant Noh Keun Suk; an undamaged MIG landed at Kimpo airport. Later at the Seoul Press Billet, the North Korean is interviewed. He Tells of Having seen Russian pilots flying MIGs and bombers into North Korea, blatantly violating the armistice agreement. Saying that he did not know of the reward the pilot asks for and receives political asylum. Further offers to MIG pilots have been withdraw and Lieutenant Noh's plane may be sent back but he can have the 100-thousand dollars, tax free.
