THE XXTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CONSTITUTION OF PALANGE ESPAÑOLA.

Thousands gather in an impressive concentration to commemorate in Madrid the XXth anniversary of Falange Española. Men of all social ranks, from the farthest corners of Spain, old members, ex-combatants of the Civil War, boys from the Junior Branches all of them marking a milestone in the constitution and development of the Organization which inspired the principles of the National Movement. From their ranks come the majority of those who now hold important offices in the government of the State.

While the banners and pennants flutter in the wind, the men intone the hymn of Falange rending with its patriotic stanzas the afternoon air.....

When the act ends, the Chief of the State abandons the Stadium of Chamartín amidst the cheers and acclamations of the crowds. Practically and enthusiastically these men, from all parts of Spain, seal and confirm their unflinching devotion and adhesion to the Leader.

A giant demonstration is then formed..... the human mass makes its way to the "Secretaría General," or Office of the General Secretariat of Falange, situated in the Calle de Alcalá. To give an idea of the magnitude of this parade, suffice it to say that it took more than an hour and a half for the last demonstrators to leave the Stadium since the head of the parade had abandoned it.

Sr. Raimundo Fernández Cuesta, Secretary General, appears in the main balcony of the building accompanied by the Labour Minister, Sr. Giron, to correspond to the cheers coming from the street. The men pass by singing and cheering as a climax to a day of unforgettable memory.
