	150.000 veterans of the 1st World War gathered at Redipuglia war cemetery to commemorate Nov 4th (armistice day) This cemetery holds 650.000 soldiers who died in the first world war.			
	The hon. Giuseppe Pella, president of the Italian Council was present at the ceremony, his presence giving importance to the event. Mr. Pella palced a wreath on the monument in the cemetery and listened to the Mass which was said by army chaplain Mons. Ferrero di Cavallerleone.			
	Representatives of all branches of the armed forces were present at the ceremony. Trieste was represented by veterans of the 1st world war and by younger men. At the end of the ceremony the crowd gathered around Mr. Pella and for a while not even the police force was able to clear a path for his exit.			
	The Trieste group which participated at the Redipuglia ceremony, returned to their city and there staged an improvised parade. Cries of: "Trieste is Italian territory", "Trieste must be returned to Italy" etc. rose from the paraders and flags were unfurled. The Allied Military Governor Gen. Winterton had emanated a proclamation that parades would not be allowed in Trieste these days. The Police force met the parade and began breaking up the parade first with police clubs and then with rifle stocks. The demonstrators answered using stones and tables taken from sidewalk cafés.
