A speculative shot by inside-left Hassell was misjudged by Smythe. In 30-seconds Ireland were one down.

The Irishmen retaliated. England goal-keeper Merrick was lucky to keep them out on more than one occasion.

At forward England almost had four passengers. Once again only Matthews at outside-right played up to International standard.
