The one shot is attached to a Vauxhall Wyvern light car. Shot one in the garage that is being fixed to a land Rover.

Queer glass bottles etc in the front seat, has been fixed for the R.A.C. tests, for the exact amount of gas oil used.

Various shots of the engine in the Vauxhall, which seems to run O.K. but I think myself, too noisy for the ordinary car. It is of course cheaper to run and has much fewer parts than the petrol engine, consequently, it does wear out so quick.
