The "Scorpion", twin-jet F-86C all-weather interceptor, the Air Force's newest addition to the Alaskan Air Command.

Armed with cannon, the latest radar, electronic search gear and rockets, the "Scorpion" has a speed of six hundred miles per hour, plus a range of 2,000 miles, providing day and night protection against atom, or hydrogen bomb attacks. The latest "Scorpion" -- the F-86D -- is all-rocket -- 104 air-to-air missiles heaviest firepower of any U.S. fighter.

Able to climb higher than 40,000 feet, the "Scorpion" is our first line of defense, on top of the world.
