Herewith the descriptions of the hats photographed yesterday in Berkeley Square.

1st Hat. "Burma" Swathed velveteen cap in brown with smog veil in caramel chiffon caught up with pearl drops.

"Highwayman" Folded pillbox in black and stone velveteen with Highwayman's mask mounted on chenille spotted veiling.

2nd Hat. "Venetian" Pale yellow straw jersey pillbox braided with black and with a mask of black lace and net.

"Balaclava" A cover-up hat, ideal for metering and cold weather wear, in golden beige jersey with mock leopard button.

These hats retail at about 7 gns with the exception of "Balaclava" which will sell at about fifty shillings.
