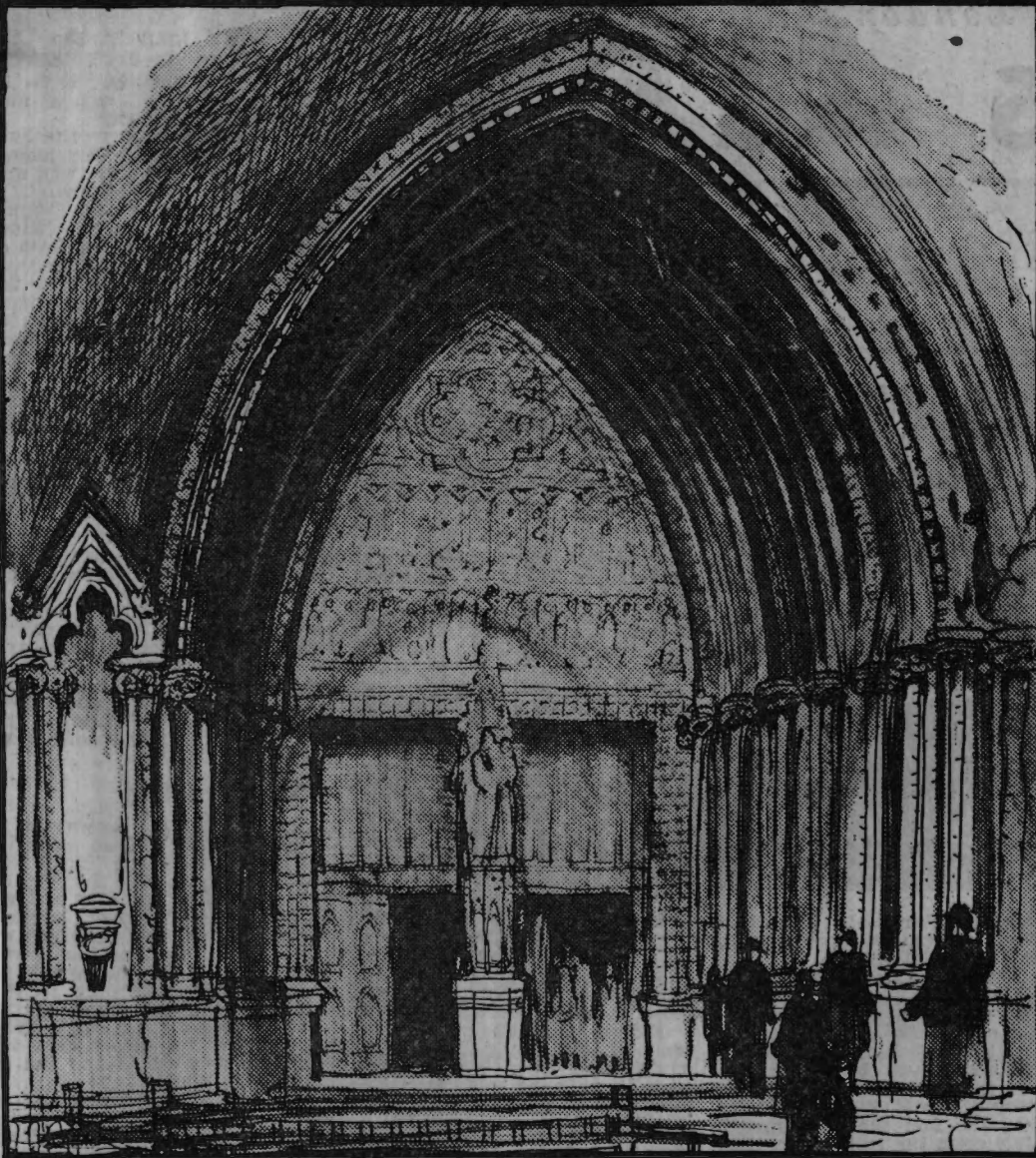

"When all is said and done the Abbey, which is England, must suffer with England, but what has been knocked down will arise in the great pile of buildings, more glorious than ever. Our duty is to carry on and, God helping us, carry on we will."

—Written after a severe air raid in May, 1941, by The Right Rev. Dr. Paul F. D. de Labilliere (Dean of Westminster, 1938-46).
