IT IS THE CUSTOM OF THIS ANCIENT CORPORATION TO SINGLE OUT FROM TIME TO

TIME FOR THE HIGHEST HONOUR.... THE FREEDOM OF THIS CITY THOSE WHO, IN ONE
WAY OR ANOTHER, HAVE RENDERED GREAT AND OUTSTANDING SERVICE TO THE NATION

OR TO THE WORLD AT LARGE. AND SO IN THE NAME OF THE CORPORATION OF LONDON

I EXTEND TO MR. CLEMENT ATTLEE A WARM AND CORDIAL WELCOME. (APPLAUSE)

OFFER THE RIGHTHAND OF FELLOWSHIP AND GREET YOU ONCE AGAIN AS A CITIZEN AND FREEMAN OF LONDON (*pplouse). IN THE NAME OF THE CORPORATION OF LONDON I PRESENT YOU WITH THIS CASKET AS A LITTLE MOMENTO OF TODAY.....RESOLUTION OF THE FORTHCOMING COUNCIL VOTING YOU THE HONORARY FREEDOM OF THIS CITY. THAT YOU MAY ENJOY HEALTH AND HAPPINESS IN AN ERA OF PEACE IS THE HEARTFELT WISH OF MY FELLOW CITIZENS. (*pplouse)

(applause as Attlee stands) -... THE HONORARY FREEDOM OF THE GREATEST CITY

IN THE WORLD. I SHOULD LIKE ALSO TO THANK THE CHAMBERLAIN FOR THE VERY

KIND THINGS HE SAID ABOUT ME. I AM A LONDONNER BORN AND BRED. TRUE I WASN'T

BORN WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS - A FEW OF MY GENERATION WERE - BUT I THINK

THAT ON A QUIET NIGHT WITH A FAVOURABLE WIND I MIGHT HAVE HEARD BOW BELLS.

(laughter) ARK THOUGH I NEVER HEARD THEM SAY "TURN AGAIN ATTLEE, FREEMAN

OF LONDON" (applause) 7 YEARS AGO. MORE THAN 200 YRS AGO ANCESTORS

OF MINE WERE LIVING.....(laughter) BUT I HAVE ALWAYS BEEN A STUDENT OF HISTORY

AND STANDING HERE I TURN TO THE TIME SO FRESH IN OUR MEMORY WHEN THIS CITY

ENDURED WITH COURAGE AND RESOLUTION THE WORST THAT THE MALICE OF HITLER COULD

INFLICT, AND SHE BEARS TODAY THOSE HONOURABLE SCARS. THRU ALL THESE CHANGES

AND CHANCES THE CITY HAS PRESERVED ITS ANCIENT INSTITUTIONS AND ITS INIQUE CHARACTER. WE LIVE IN AN AGE WHEN THE TIDES OF CHANGE ARE RUNNING STRONGLY, AND WHEN MANY OLD LANDMARKS ARE BEING SWEPT AWAY. I HAVE THOUGHT IT MY DUTY TO TAKE PART IN AND TO FURTHER SOME OF THESE CHANGES, BUT I WOULD NEVER WANTONLY DESTROY THINGS BECAUSE THEY ARE OLD. I HAVE A LOVE OF ANCIENT THINGS - I LIKE TO KEEP OLD INSTUTIONS AND SEE THEM TURNED TO NEW USES..... ON THE RIVERSIDE WE SHALL ALWAYS BE CONSCIOUS OF OUR GREAT RIVER. I WAS GLAD ON MY RECENT TOUR OF THE DOCKS TO HEAR A CITIZEN OF ANOTHER COUNTRY SAYING THIS IS STILL THE GREATEST PORT IN THE WORLD. THE CITY OF LONDON HAS HELD THE NAME..... EARTHQUAKE, FIRE OR FLOOD FALLS ON HAPLESS PROPLE OUR FIRST THOUGHT IS FOR A FUND. THE LATEST OF THESE WAS THAT MOST SUCCESSFUL APPEAL FOR THE FLOODS ON THE E. COAST LAUNCHED BY THE LATE LORD MAYOR KNEXEKS WORTHILY UPHELD HIS POSITION..... IN OUR CITY THE GREAT DOME OF ST. PAULS FITLY SYMBOLIZES THE SUPERIORITY OF THE SPIRITUAL OVER THE MATERIALS. MY LORD MAYOR, THERE IS IT IS TO MY MIND ONE OF THE ESSENTIALS OF DEMOCRACY ... THAT IS THE SPIRIT OF TOLERANCE, TOLERANCE NOT FOR EVIL BUT FOR THE LICE DIVERSITIES OF VIEW. IT WAS JUST THIS WHICH ENABLED US WHEN THE DAYS OF TREAL CAME TO STAND TOGETHER IN THE DEFENCE OF OUR COUNTRY AND OF THOSE THINGS WE ALL HELD DEAR. (applause) HONOUR BESTOWED UPON ME TODAY. (applause)
