Running Story.

The international Ski Jumping-Tournament at Bischofshofen was the High Light of 3 tournaments held in Germany and Austria. The best ski-jumpers from seven nations (Sweden, Norway, Finland, Yugoslavia, Germany, Switzerland and Austria) were competing.

It was clear from the beginning that, and that was primarily believed after the 3 previous tournaments, the Scandinavians would win. But to the surprise and joy of Austrians, the 36 year old Austrian Jumper SEPP BRADL (No. ~~22~~ 29) scored best after an terrific battle between Olaf BJORNSTAD (No. 18), Olympic Champ ~~and~~ Arnfin BERGMAN (No. 28) and Sepp BRADL the latter succeeded with the longest jump (91 metres) and also with the most overall points.
