Children's party at Scoetdijk Palace.

Some 40 children of the Princess Margriet Fund (a Fund which takes care of the relatives of those men of the mercantile marine who died in service in the 2nd World War) have attended a party on the occasion of the 11th anniversary of Princess Margriet. The Queen, Princess Beatrix and the heroine of the feast welcomed their guests personally. There were some children who just passed Margriet in haste; but Princess Beatrix saw to it that her sister wasn't passed over. It became a merry feast. Of course Princess Margriet was the central figure, and it was she who was called forward by the juggler, in order to assist him in one of his card tricks. And she did it so well, that she was allowed to keep the card on which her own portrait appeared to figure. Also Princess Marijke enjoyed herself highly. Culmination-point of the feast was the entrance of the tart, a present from the Mercantile Marine, whose godchild Princess Margriet is.
