MOROCCO

Tetuan, capital of the Spanish Zone of Morocco, and residence of H.R.H. the Caliph, comes to the world's limelight. Moroccans from all parts of the Protectorate, gather in the city to express their adhesion and loyalty to Spain and to repudiate the policy followed in the French Protectorate, particularly the overthrowing of Sultan Mohamed V.

The inhabitants of Tetuan take part in the record demonstration held in the neighborhood of the Stadium in the Avenida de Rio Martin.

Lt. Gen. Garcia Valiño, Spanish High Commissary in Morocco, arrives, surrounded by the Moorish Cavalry, to receive the tribute rendered to Spain by all the authorities among which are the Ministers of the Majzen. Chorfas, ulemas, religious brotherhoods, notables and common people are present.....

The "feuta" or notarial certificate signed by all civil and religious authorities in the Protectorate, is read. The document drawn up in Arab, "Cheija" and Spanish is solemnly handed to H.E. the High Commissary.

Lt. Gen. Garcia Valiño addresses the crowds and stresses the difference between the peace enjoyed in the Spanish zone and the anguish and discomfort prevailing in the French Protectorate. He says he shall deliver this document, which is a compensation for all the vigils and work done by Spain in pro of the progress of Morocco's noble people, to Generalissimo Franco.

The Moroccan authorities, brotherhoods, guilds march past before the platform occupied by the High Commissary with their "nubas" or music bands, pennants and flags, followed by concentrations from the "kabilas", associations and other organisations.

30.000 Moroccans took part in this tribute paid to Spain during which they applied for the circumstantial separation of the Spanish zone, proclaiming their discomformity with Muley Arafa whose Authority they deny and with whom the present Caliph, H. I.H. Prince Muley Hassam, does not wish to have any connection.
