Arrival of the Queen and Duke, meet racecourse officials.
 General shots of Trotting Race.
 Shot of the paddock Area.
 General shot of the crowd.
 Queen presents Gold Cup to winner of Royal Metropolitan Cup...
 No. 13... VAN DIEMAN....
 The Horse is garlanded.

General shot of the stands.
 Shot of the Duke looking at the runners just before starting the Duke
 of Edinburgh Stages.

The Duke gets up to the Starters Stand.
 The Duke holds on to the starting handle... finally starts the race.

Description of cut subject : " QUEEN IN DUNEDIN "

Shot of the Royal Train en route to Dunedin ... link from last place.
Shot from the Royal Carriage as train leaves Oamaru... Queen and Duke wave to crowd.

Short shot of the Queen arriving at the Town Hall ... very unimposing entrance.

Close shot of the Queen and Duke on the Balcony of the Town Hall after the Civic Reception inside... waving to the crowd.

Shots of the crowd.

Shot of the Royal Car leaving the Town Hall.

Shots of the marching girls at the Sports Meeting at Carisbrooke.

Shot of a Cycle Race.

Arrival of the Queen at the Sports Ground, and walk to the Royal Box.

Shot of the Royal Car with the Queen and the Duke as they leave.

REMARKS:

The shots at the Civic Reception and Sports meeting are part coverage as requested. Impossible to get any other pictures of the Queen at the Sports Meeting owing to the position of the Royal Box, and the necessity to use a long lens. The NZ Film Unit has two men trying to get some material.

Arrival of Queen walking between lines of nurses to front entrance of Hospital - greeted by Dr. Deem (woman) and meets other hospital representatives.

Royal Party watch from upstairs verandah - children playing in pens outside.

Queen watches Baby on scales - talks to it - baby plays with flowers of her bouquet.

Shot of Baby on Scales.

Queen watches toddlers on floor of Toddler's Room.
Queen comes out into playpen, watches children playing.
Shots of Children.

General views of Queen on Balcony.
Shots of Children playing, making wood things etc.,
General view of Hospital.
Name - Truby-King Hospital.
