Arrival of the Queen and Duke on the dais.

2" shot of the Queen and the Duke sitting on the dais.

3" shot same

6" shot of same.

Queen and Duke step into a Land Rover to drive round the Beach

Shot of the Queen and the Duke in Land Rover.

NOTE:

Up to now the conditions of working for anyone other than cameras in fixed positions with long focus lenses are completely impossible. Freedom of movement is nil, and owing to the large numbers of Press photographers on each event, reaction pictures of the Queen at functions of this sort are stopped after the first two minutes. Only those with long lenses have any chance, and they are working against the "stop". The matter is under consideration, letter following.

NOTE:

Of the subjects asked for to date... Parliament and Duke visiting University unable to cover as my name had not been put on the lists. Assembly of Schoolchildren out because impossible to get on to Anzac House, where confined to one spot. Repatriation hospital provided no pictures at all apart from some general views, so did not shoot. Randwick races, too far from Queen.
