reported to the press centre.

The programme for the competitions will be found in a separate general programme which has been given to you.

Where the competitions take place will be clear from the accompanying sketched map.

As for transports there and back, we have planned for you to take care of them yourselves. Taxis can be ordered through the hotel swithboard. We advise you to do it as early as possible.

In certain cases transports are handled through the press centre. This is the case on the night before Saturday, February 13th Then a chartered bus leaves at 11.30 p.m. for the place where the relay race starts.

Special transports for members of the press will also be arranged on Sunday, , February 14th, from the goal of the 30 km. race.at Lugnet, where it is estimated that the competitions will be practically over around noon, to the jumping-hill at Källviken, where the competitions start at 1.30 p.m. If you wish to take advantage of this special transport, however, you must necessarily get a ticket for it at the press centre on the day before. Only those furnished with tickets can be guaranteed seats.

In connections with the 50 km. race on Thursday 18th it will be possible to go out and watch the participants in the track at certain points. Special cars or buses will leave from the grand stand at Lugnet at a suitable time. Tickets for them must be taken on the day before, no later than 8 p.m. In case of oversubscription the last persons to put their names down will have to withdraw. The price is 50 öre. The buses will be back at Lugnet in good time before the participants reach the goal.

For those who have cars of their own, There is a special press card to be put on the Wind-shield, which can be obtained at the press centre. The car parks for the press are:

In town: in the yard of Trotzgatan 28  
          on the lot " Trotzgatan 18

At Lugnet: At the goal

At Källviken: at the foot of the hill and at lake Runn.

On the premises of the competitions, the car parks are conveniently near the grand stands. You may find from the sketched map yourselves, however, that in certain cases you may get stuck in the general line of traffic if you stay too long at the competitions. Under such conditions, your interests may be best served by using other car parks, situated further away and open to the public. In that case you must decide for yourselves. Do not blame us. You have been warned.

As regards entertainments we direct you to the memorandum of the entertainment committee and to other separate papers that may be found in your fike.

Moreover: Keep well up to date with what goes on by studying regularly the big press bulletin boards.

M E M O R A N D U M No. I.

Below is given a guide to the arrangements made to support and facilitate the work of the press in connection with the World Ski Championships at Falun. You will also find information on various local conditions and arrangements.

Therefore read this memorandum carefully.

Falun has Sweden's biggest jumping-hill and excellent grounds for cross-country runs on skis. The town has good communications and a comparatively reliable winter climate, but it is not a big town. It has only 17.000 inhabitants. Consequently, resources are limited. However, practically all the inhabitants of the town have taken part in the preparations for the World Ski Championships and have done what they could to enable us to receive all the guests at the World Championships in a suitable manner. This goes not least for the members of the press. All the big hotels have been put at the disposal of the press, except one, the Grand Hotell, where we have however accommodated the radio men and their head-quarters. In several cases enlargements and new furnishings have taken place, telephone switchboards have been reinforced and attendance increased. It is nevertheless clear to us that though everything within the bounds of the possible has been done, we have not been able to arrange everything in the ideal manner for everybody. We apologize for this and hope that you will enjoy yourselves and notice that you are still heartily welcome.

Your identification badge as a reporter, a photographer or a radio man was given to you together with this memorandum. This is the only identification we distribute. When provided with your name and that of your newspaper, it grants you free entrance, at the competitions to the spectators' stands reserved for the press, it gives you access to the press centre etc. But it must necessarily be worn where it is clearly visible. No other document entitles you to similar advantage. We have established this rule to your own advantage. We do not want unauthorized persons to be able to intrude on the premises of your work.

N.B. If you intend to go on to Åre after the competitions at Falun are over, take your identification with you there. It is valid there too.

Concerning hotel accommodations, meals, subscriptions and prices, you will find information in a special memorandum in the file you have received.

The Press Centre is located in room 108 on the ground floor of the Stadshotellet. Between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. there will always be people there, whose job is to give you all the information you may need and to comply to your wishes to the best of their ability. They all speak at least one more language besides Swedish.

All materiel, printed or stenciled, about the competitions will be distributed through a cabinet where each newspaper has its own compartment. You got a key to it when you arrived. We must ask you to return it when you leave. The post office department charges us 5 crowns for each lost key.

Three press hosts also belong to the personnel of the press centre: viz. Mr. Sten Svensson and the heads of the press office, Mr. Rydberg and Mr. Herdin. Mr. Svensson lives in the building where the press office is located.

The telegraphic and telephonic communications are dealt with in a separate memorandum. Special wishes and complaints may be
