

## FAMOUS LADIES LAUNCH TWO SHIPS

World Harmony, biggest tanker ever built in Britain, was named at Vickers-Armstrongs' Naval Yard, Walker-on-Tyne, by the Duchess of Kent.

The 33,000-tonner will trade between the Persian Gulf and Britain. The Greek firm that ordered the ~~min~~ tanker have commissioned Vickers Armstrong to build more ships, totalling 300,000 tons.
