Inside Independence Hall, Philadelphia refugees from Iron Curtain countries tapped out a freedom message on the liberty bell. Then at Springfield, Illinois, three shifts worked all round the clock making freedom balloons; the same ~~kind~~ ^{kind} that are released across the Red frontiers in Europe to carry a message of hope to the enslaved peoples. These balloons, like the tour of the freedom tank, raised funds for radio propoganda ~~which~~ directed through the Iron Curtain.
