- 1. Remembering that the Billy Graham Crusade meetings are essentially Church meetings, the same courtesy and restraint which would be shown in covering a Church service should be observed.
- 2. It will not be possible to permit flash photographs during the sermon. Mr. Graham will be speaking briefly during the opening portions of the meeting prior to the sermon, and during that time it will be possible to secure pictures of him delivering a message.
- 3. Photographs may be made during the opening part of the meeting -- that is, during the congregational singing, etc. Normal courtesy and consideration for those who have come to worship should be observed.
- 4. During the appeal or invitation at the conclusion of the sermon, no pictures are to be made.
- 5. No pictures are to be made in the Counselling Room at the close of the meeting.
- <u>NOTE</u>: For any special photographic requirements, please check with the Public Relations Staff, Mr. Jerry Beavan, or Miss Betty Lowry, one of whom will always be at the Press Table.
