 lens denotes half time....

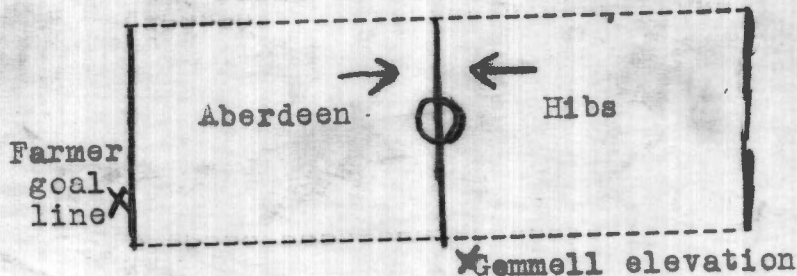
Roll three continues from same position up till the finish.
