

WORLD SKI CHAMPIONSHIPS

Ladies' Day on the Giant Slalom at Aare, Sweden, in the World Ski-ing Championships. Janette Burr, America, came 3rd; her time for the 1,420-yard course, with its 1,000-foot fall, was 1-minute, 41.7.
