CARACAS, VENEZUELA DULLES GIVES WARNING ON REDS

Caracas, Venezuela scene of the Inter-American Conference, being held for the first time since 1948. Heading the U.S. delegation is Secretary of State Dulles. Mr. Dulles, in what is regarded as the first definitive statement of the Eisenhower administration toward Latin America, takes the initiative by introducing before the 20-nation conference, a strong anti-Red resolution. It is called a "Declaration of Solidarity for the Preservation of the Political Integrity of the American States Against International Communism." Earlier Mr. Dulles had bluntly spoken out for a warning to the Reds against Communist infiltration of the hemisphere.
