Present just back from/fact-finding was defence minister Pleven. Viet Nam seeks independence within the French union. Meanwhile, in Indo China itself fighting goes on. French Union forces counter-attacked the enemy in the Thai country near Dien Bien Phu. (tank 8 troops) That softening-up seemed to justify 1 *SOVW* infantry attack. The Viet Minh rebel forces don't hold a line; they occupy small and well-chosen pockets, always with natural cover, always difficult to root out. No wonder France hopes much from the forthcoming Geneva will be conference, where Indo-China mittrix high up on the agenda .
