After a long flight by Constellation from Melbourne the Queen and Duke of Edinburgh arrive at Eagle farm Brisbane to begin their tour of Queensland.

PAUSE

At the airport Her Majesty is welcomed by State Governor Sir John Lavarack and Lady Lavarack, Queensland Premier Cair and other dignitaries. An interesting programme awaits the Royal couple in the north with a visit to the Barrier Reef.

PAUSE

An impressive guard of honour has been drawn from the R.A.A.F. Station at Amberley. As the progress of Government House begins, cheering crowds at the airport are a prelude to the citizens' welcome in Brisbane's gaily bedecked streets. Queensland lives up to its reputations for warmhearted friendliness.

PAUSE

The Royal couple pause in their progress to visit Queensland's War Memorial The Shrine of Remembrance, and are escorted by officials to the Eternal Flame.

PAUSE

A solemn moment as royalty pays tribute to the fallen of two world wars.

PAUSE

In spite of almost tropical heat Her Majesty looks her usual cool and radiant self.

PAUSE

At the Exhibition Grounds the royal party arrives for a civic reception and is escorted around the arena by a mounted guard of honour. Her Majesty thoughtfully lowers her silk parasol to be seen better by deliriously happy crowds.

PAUSE

Queensland has a light-hearted yet deeply loyal welcome for Her Majesty and the Duke as they begin their tour of Australia's romantic north.
