STORY: SECRETARY OF STATE AT WAKAMBA SHOW. Location: Kitui, Kenya.

- Roll 1. Mr. Oliver Lyttelton and the Governor, Sir Evelyn Baring, arriving at Kitui to visit the Agricultural Show, March 10; travelling by air from Nairobi immediately after announcing new constitutional proposals. Shots of speeches to assembled Wakamba by Sec. of State, Governor and C.I.G.S. (in uniform), also Provincial Commissioner, Mr. E. A. Sweatman.
- Roll 2. Speeches at show ground - African speaker is Chief Kasina, a Mkamba Chief of the Kitui district who lost both hands recently when attacked by malcontents in his tribe.
- Roll 3. Wakamba bowmen in archery contest during show. Lyttelton presented shield to best team and himself received bow and arrows as gift, also Baring. Other shots of Sec. of State's tour of show-grounds inspecting Kamba crafts, cattle, etc.
- Roll 4. (Quality poor.) Archery contest and prize-giving to Kamba contestants. Close-up pictures of Kamba dancers in their beads and finery.
- Roll 5. Kamba dancing in progress, feature of these dances being rhythmic movements and occasionally fantastic leaps and somersaults by male dancers.
- Roll 6. Mr. Lyttelton and Governor watch Kamba dancers.
