#### DRAMATIC SEA RESCUE

Down there is the fishing boat Student Prince the Second, disabled in mountainous seas. As Coast Guard aircraft maintain the vigil, the liner Queen of Bermuda races 150 miles off her course -- to the rescue! Some <sup>200</sup> 300 miles northeast of Bermuda, amid the treacherous waves and roaring winds, a drama of the Atlantic. The rescue is witnessed by passengers aboard the Queen, which sent a lifeboat out into the storm. Ten crewmen from the fishing vessel are picked up--and then, the fight to reach the side of the liner. The pressures of the storm thrust the hulk of the Student Prince close to the liner, requiring skillful maneuvering of the big vessel. Finally, after 30 tense minutes, the lifeboat is alongside-- and now the breathless moments as it is made secure. At last, the crewmen are safely aboard -- an heroic rescue completed!
