2. CU FUCHS SPEAKS *caption*  
 "THE CONTINENT IS A VAST AREA ABOUT THE SAME SIZE AS EUROPE AND THE U.S. PUT TOGETHER. WITH THE EXPEDITION OF AMUNDSENS AND SCOTT'S JOURNEY TO THE POLE ONLY THE MARGINAL AREAS ARE KNOWN." 21
3. SCU CONTINUES:  
 "THE LENGTH OF OUR JOURNEY WILL BE ABOUT ~~1,500~~ 1,750-MILES, AND ABOUT 1,500 MILES OF THAT WILL BE THROUGH NEW TERRITORY, NOT EVEN SEEN FROM THE AIR. THE OBJECTS OF THE EXPEDITION ARE NOT ONLY EXPLORATORY, BUT INCLUDE A NUMBER OF SPECIAL SCIENTIFIC STUDIES. FOR INSTANCE, SOUND-~~THE~~ DEPTH OF THE POLAR ICE-CAP, WHICH IS KNOWN TO BE AS MUCH AS 8,000-ft IN SOME PLACES." 40
