	<p>According to tradition, which dates back many years, animals are blessed on the day dedicated to Sant'Antonio Abate (St. Anthony the Abbot) who has been designed as the protector of all animals.</p>			
	<p>The religious service took place as usual in the Church of S. Eusebio at Piazza Vittorio. Citizens bring their pets and work animals stopping patiently waiting for the priest to come and bless them. Cats, dogs, canaries, tortoises, guinea pigs etc. Drivers of the characteristic roman "Carrozzelle" (horse drawn carriages) brought their horses for a blessing.</p>			
	<p>A similar ceremony took place at a circus which is in town in this period. Here the animals of the menagerie were blessed: Elephants, camels, dromedaries, lions and other ferocious animals were given the same treatment as pets.</p>
