SCENES in the air - in & from a "Dartmouth" RAF plane, on a mercy mission with hay for isolated farmers. First shot of morning take off from inside plane looking past pilot should show runway lights

The location of the hay drop is Bettyhill on the north coast of Scotland.

Out-to-air shots of Dakota plane dropping hay at same location.

The planes taking part in similar hay dropping missions are flying from the RAF base at Kinloss on the Moray Firth coast & include, Shackletons, Neptunes, Dantys, Dakotas planes.

Roll 3 also contains shots on RAF control of hay being loaded on to a Neptunes.

B.B.E set out on similar mission but returned because of bad weather
