The order of the proceedings...
 Procession through the City to the City Hall where the Lord Provost, Thomas Kerr, throws money about, and welcomes the Charity Queen, Miss Delney Goalen, an art student... various shots of the Lord Provost with the Queen..a shot rather dark of the chief constable in private cloths, Sup Dockerty (perhaps not the correct spelling, but it is how the name is pronounced) and reasonable to all the Press, useful to us if it can be used.... various shots of the students collecting around the town and various stunts to get money from the starving ScotIs..

In the afternoon, the opening of the boxes and extracting money collected....poor artificial light...

In the evening a torch light procession from the City Hall up to the University, where fun & games etc, go on to the early hours..about 2000 students took part in this procession..

In the main the floats were poor, possibly owing to the bad weather, it rained all night, and the procession started almost darkness, that is why I only covered the City end of the procession, as this was one & half hours later..
