THE MATTER WHICH MY GOVERNMENT - THE NZ GOV - IS RAISING BEFORE THE SECURITY COUNCIL, IS THE QUESTION OF THE HOSTILITIES IN THE AREA OF CERTAIN ISLANDS OFF THE COAST OF THE MAINLAND OF CHINA.

THE OBJECT OF MY GOV. IN RAISING THIS MATTER BEFORE THE SEC. COUNCIL IS TO BRING ABOUT A CESSATION OF THE FIGHTING IN A NUMBER OF ISLANDS CLOSE TO THE CHINESE COAST.

THE CONTINUANCE OF ARMED CLASHES BETWEEN CHINESE COMMUNISTS AND CHINESE NATIONALIST FORCES OVER A PERIOD OF MONTHS HAS CAUSED MY GOV. INCREASING AND GRAVE CONCERN.

AS A COUNTRY IN THE PACIFIC NZ NATURALLY VIEWS WITH ANXIETY ANY HOSTILITIES IN THAT AREA.

IN THE PARTICULAR CIRCUMSTANCES OF THIS CASE WE SEE IN THE POSSIBILITY OF CONTINUED FIGHTING IN THE OFFSHORE ISLANDS A DANGER OF WIDER CONFLAGRATION. WE SEE A POTENTIAL THREAT TO INTERNATIONAL PEACE AND SECURITY.

AS A MEMBER OF THE SEC. COUNCIL WHOSE FUNCTION IT IS TO DEAL WITH A SITUATION OF THIS KIND THE NZ GOVERNMENT HAS CONSIDERED IT IS BOUND TO REQUEST THE COUNCIL TO EXAMINE THE PROBLEM.

THE SOLE AIM OF OUR INITIATIVE IS TO STOP THE FIGHTING. THIS IS, IN ITSELF, IN THE VIEW OF MY GOV. A SUBSTANTIAL AND IMMEDIATE OBJECTIVE. THE RESULT WE BELIEVE WOULD BE TO LESSEN TENSION AND TO STRENGTHEN THE FABRIC OF WORLD PEACE. IF, BY REASON OF OUR INITIATIVE TENSION CAN BE REDUCED, THE POSSIBILITY OF ADJUSTING OTHER PROBLEMS IN THE AREA PEACEFULLY AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PURPOSES AND PRINCIPLES OF THE UNITED NATIONS CHARTER RATHER THAN BY RESORT TO FORCE WILL BE INCREASED.

LODGE

MR. PRESIDENT, WHEN I HEAR THE SOVIET UNION TELLING OTHERS NOT TO INTERFERE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF ANOTHER COUNTRY I REALLY FEEL THAT I CAN HONESTLY SAY THAT I HAVE HEARD EVERYTHING.

HERE'S THIS SOVIET ~~REG~~ REGIME WHICH ALWAYS INTERFERES TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT POSSIBLE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF ALL COUNTRIES - WHICH HAS INTERFERED AND IS INTERFERING WITH DEADLY EFFECT AND TO THE FULL EXTENT OF ITS POWER IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF CHINA. UNCTION (?)  
HERE'S THIS REGIME, IN A TONE OF... IF YOU PLEASE, MAKING A CHARGE OF INTERFERENCE AGAINST THE UNITED STATES.

THIS IS AGGRESSION IN THE MODERN WORLD, MR. PRESIDENT. IT IS COMMUNISM. THERE IS THE REAL AGGRESSOR.

IF THE COMMUNISTS ARE REALLY OPPOSED TO WAR AND VIOLENCE AS THEIR STATEMENT INFERS, THEY CAN EASILY DEMONSTRATE IT BY JOINING THE PEACE-LOVING NATIONS OF THE WORLD IN SUPPORTING THE CESSATION OF HOSTILITIES. THAT IS WHY WE OF THE FREE WORLD ARE HERE TODAY.

WE ARE READY TO SUPPORT THE UNITED NATIONS' EFFORT TO END THE PRESENT HOSTILITIES IN THE AREA, BUT WE ALSO ARE UNITED IN OUR DETERMINATION TO DEFEND AN AREA VITAL TO THE SECURITY OF THE UNITED STATES AND TO THE FREE WORLD.
