COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES

Newman camera.

1. Lord Mountbatten -the new Sea Lord- arrives for the parade
2. The instection by Lord Mountbatten
3. Several shots of the march past with longer lens on Lord Mountbatten taking the salute ( very poor light)
4. The winner of the Sword of Honour -Senior Under Officer P.I.Dell - is presented with the sword by Lord Mountbatten
5. The winner of the Queen's Medal -Senior Under Officer R.J.N.Leonard -gets his medal
6. General views as the cadets slow march up the College steps
7. The Adjutant on his horse goes up the steps -general view (to lead up to close up during rehearsal)
8. Cut-in on spectators.

Le Blay camera.

1. General view during inspection
2. Other general views on e of which is during 'Present Arms' to cut in as Mountbatten arrives & before inspection
3. Two shots of Lady Mountbatten watching
4. Marching shots
5. Spectator shots with officers saluting as Colours go by.

Note. 'Auld Lang Syne' is played during slow march up the steps and part of the time during quich march past 'John Peel' was played
