GENERAL IMPORMATION ON KANO.

THE HOLD OF KANO'S PALACE, COMMENT CHANGES AND COURT HOUSE.

The Brir's Palace was established on this site by the Hense Brir Nohamadu Rumfa nearly 500 years ago. The area of the Palace is 33 acres. The Central gatemy was rebuilt in macony 25 years ago. The building on the right of the Gatemy is the Brir's Central on the left there is the Native Authority Council Chember.

KANG CITT MOSQUE,

A part of the funds for the construction of this Mesque was raised by public subscription and the remainder was provided by the Native Authority. The construction of the Mosque was completed in 1947.

THE HASSADAWA GATE,
