GENERAL INFORMATION ON KANO.

THE EMIR OF KANO'S PALACE, COUNCIL CHAMBER AND COURT HOUSE:

The Emir's Palace was established on this site by the Hausa Emir Mohamadu Rumfa nearly 500 years ago. The area of the Palace is 33 acres. The Central gateway was rebuilt in masonry 25 years ago. The building on the right of the Gateway is the Emir's Court and on the left there is the Native Authority Council Chamber.

KANO CITY MOSQUE.

A part of the funds for the construction of this Mosque was raised by public subscription and the remainder was provided by the Native Authority. The construction of the Mosque was completed in 1947.

THE MASSARAWA GATE.

One of the thirteen original gateways to Kano City. The old City walls which are eleven miles in circumference may be seen on either side of the Gate.

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
