

HEARTS BEAT RANGERS

30 Hearts Captain, Glidden, lost the toss to the great George Young, in the seventh-round tie against Rangers. So Hearts kicked off at Tynecastle, where nearly 50,000 expected a vintage game. As it was 61 years since Hearts beat Rangers in a ~~cup~~^{cup tie} they were not exactly favourites, even with their own supporters.

43 After 36 minutes Hearts outside-right ~~Young~~ put the ball to the opposite winger and outside-left Crawford headed Hearts' first goal.

62 In Just over a minute Hearts were two up. Good work by Conn and Wardhaugh put centre-forward Bauld in possession, and Willy made no mistake.
