Especially during the last days of the ice-period in Holland, helicopters of the Dutch Military Porces were almost without interruption in the air, in order to help man and animal. Many of these heli-actions were made for the dropping of food for the hungry birds.

The helicopters were used also to build air-lifts, there where the ferry-boats threatened to fall out, e.g. in Zealand, where the connections between the northern islands and the shore were seriously hindered by the ice. Only the very heavy ferry-boats could travel, though with great delay. All the other vessels laid jammed in the ice.

The helicopters also dropped tons of feed for the hungy in birds. Even those birds which always prefer the open country, were now in the vicinity of the housing-quarters. E.g. thousands of coots in the Northseasanal. When you see them potter about you have no idea of the great execution which was done among the water-fowl.

Those birds which survived the freesing-death, are still in danger, as they are very much weakened. It has been decided therefore, to continue these food-droppings.
