Present at the ceremony were several civil religious and military authorities. Among these Italian undersecretary for defense Gen. Giovanni Bovotti, U.S. Consul General Boswell and Col. Hoffman.</p> <p>The new Fiat O/M 6600 was presented. This truck has a 210 HP motor and can reach the speed of 85km per hour on a normal highway and weighs 22 tons. This machine can also cross water which isn't over 2 meters in depth. The machine was put thru its paces amid the cheers of the factory workers.</p> <p>The Fiat O.M. factory is building 339 more vehicles of the same model which are to be given over to MENEM the armed forces of other European Countries which are members of the NATO Organization.</p>
