COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF SCENES

This afternoon the Archbishop went to Athens to have meetings with the Greek Government on the Cyprus problem after the deadlock from the meetings he had here with the Governor of Cyprus Sir John Harding and the Secretary of States Mr. Lenox Boyd, on a sunshine day at 1.30 pm. he went to the airport and Athenswards. Before that time all schools students and large crowd of people have been gathered at the Archbishopic to see their leader leaving for the Airport. Students were ringing the bells of the Archbishopic church from 12 noon, and other small boys have come with greek flags made by themselves. other proper flags were carried by bigger boys.

Shots.:

boys sitting on the Archbishopic walls with greek flags waiting the Archbishop to pass by....other shots of the Students while are ringing the bells of the Church....the Archbishop Makarios coming down the steps of the Archbishopic followed by other church leaders...(he then enters the church Shot while he is ~~entering~~ coming out of the church followed by crowd of people and cheering him....entering the car and leaving for the airport... at the main gade of the Airport the car was stoped by security forces and after cheking who was he was let to pass..

Further to the above story I have covered the following in No.2.Roll.

When the Archbishop went to the airport, after about one hour large force of the paratroops regiments 3rd. Battalion., have blocated all the archbishopic area from all sides and searches took place all over the buildings and yards around..Here are several shots of the Archbishopic square with troops standing by after the area was blocated...troops can be seen also at the oposite of the Archbishopic pemises with soldiers on roofs where is the Pancyprrian Gymnasioum now closed...other shots of the troops with the Archbishopic and greek flags on mast with background close up soldiers with guns behind the walls of the Archbishopic yards.
