## THE SHOW JUMPING SECTION OF THE BRITISH EQUESTRIAN TEAM

Details of the riders and horses which had been selected to train, were issued to the Press last November.

### Training to date

Riders started work on their horses at their homes early in January, and during the period before collecting at Ascot, their trainer, Lt. Col. G. A. Lightfoot-Boncompagni, visited each of them to see how their horses were.

The team came together here during the first week in March and immediately on arrival were inspected by the Veterinary Officer. Since then they have been doing steady work to get them fit. Each day the trainer allows half an hour of his time to each horse individually when he watches it jump - up to date over small fences only. Before this the riders have been riding their horses in getting them warmed up and supplied, either in Windsor Great Park or near the Stud. As well as this during the day the riders have been taking their horses for long slow exercises in the park, and once or twice a week they have all been going there together to canter and gallop their horses for about two miles.

### Today's Trial

Each horse will jump a long and fairly large course for the first time since the training started. The length of the course will be approximately 4 1/2 to 5 miles. The length of the course will be 250 yds.

Photographers will be allowed to take pictures of the jumping in the normal way, but it will not be possible to arrange for any further jumping pictures other than taking the actual round. Opportunities will also be given for taking pictures of riders and their horses either on the course or in the park.

### Future Plans

The team will have their first public trial on April 25th and 26th. Then they will go to the Horse Trials (April 28th-30th) where they will compete.
