Near the end Alan Prescott himself forced his way over for another St. Helens try.... Rhodes's kick hit the post.

20 So Alan Prescott received the cup from the hands of Lord Alexander. St. Helens had won, 13-2. Prescott didn't know it at this stage but he was awarded the Lance Todd Trophy as outstanding player of the match.
