Polie, as we now prefer to call infantile paralysis, is perhaps the disease that parents of young children dread most. That is very understandable because, whilst it is true grown up people are attacked, it is the young children especially who are most liable to catch it.

Polio, as we now prefer to call infantile paralysis, is the disease that parents of pung children parage dread most. This is very understandable. Whilst it is true that grown up people are attacked it is the children, especially the young children, who are most liable to catch it, and it is often the healthiest and the liveliest who are struck down. Fortunately the majority of them get completely well again but some are cruelly orippled for life.

vaccine will not catch polic this summer, but the chances will be greatly reduced, and in particular, there will be less risk of permanent paralysis, and, after all, it is the paralysis that we want

I am very sorry that we shall not be able, at the present time, to vaccinate all that have been registered. We may not be able to vaccinate more than one in four, but they will have the first chance when we start again this Autumn, and I hope that we shall have much greater

Finally I don't regard this vaccine as the last word. Research is still going on and one day we may have a more protective method against polic....(I shall have to say that again.)

Finally May I say that I don't regard this vaccine as the last word. Research is still going on, which may one day mean that we will have an even more production methania effective method of protection, but for the first time we have a means of protecting thousands of children from this dreaded disease, and that is why I believe today we are taking a great step forward.
