The Press Passes you requested for the Review of the St. John Ambulance Brigade by H.M. The Queen in Hyde Park on May 12th are enclosed herewith. alread

The Press arrangements for the Review; which will take place at the Marble Arch end of Hyde Park, are as follows:-

Newsreel Stand - just outside the roped area on the North flank of the Parade, level with the front rank of the Parade.

Photographers' Enclosure - roped in enclosure 20 yards to the right of the Dais, jutting out 20ft. towards the Parade and marching line. This enclosure is 20ft. long. There will be a passage-way to enable messengers to come and go.

Reporters Enclosure - seats for reporters will be directly behind the photographers.

"Roving" Photographers' - up to ten photographers will be allowed on each flank of the Parade. These two groups will be accompanied by St. John Officers and will be able to move up and down to get photographs of The Queen as she inspects the Parade in her Land Rover.

Rota Passes - The Queen's arrival and departure and the Presentations will be on a rota basis. One newsreel, three still photographers and two reporters will be issued with special passes to cover these events.

Arrangements will be made for messengers to park their motor-bicycles near to the Parade.

All photographers with "rota" and "roving" passes should contact Mr. Lees or Mrs. Wyndham at the Dais not later than 2.40 p.m. so that they can get into position before the arrival of the Royal Party.

The Time Schedule is as follows:-

2.50-3 p.m. Arrival of Royal Party; First car, H.R.H. The Duke of Gloucester (Grand Prior of the Order of St. John) and the Duchess of Gloucester (Deputy Commandant-in-Chief St. John Ambulance Brigade); Second car, H.M. The Queen (Sovereign Head of the Order of St. John) and H.R.H. The Princess Margaret (Commandant-in-Chief of St. John Ambulance Brigade Cadets). (ON ROTA)
