ROYAL REVIEW

On Saturday 12th May, 1956 at 3.0 p.m. Her Majesty The Queen (Sovereign Head of the Order of St. John) will review 21,000 adult members and 1,000 cadets of the St. John Ambulance Brigade in Hyde Park.

This is the first time that a reigning Sovereign has reviewed the St. John Ambulance Brigade since 1912, when King George V held a review at Windsor.

The Queen will be accompanied by H.R.H. The Princess Margaret (Commandant-in-Chief, St. John Ambulance Brigade Cadets) and by the Duke of Gloucester (Grand Prior of the Order of St. John) and the Duchess of Gloucester. The Royal Party will arrive at 3 o'clock, when the Queen will tour the lines of St. John Ambulance Brigade members in a Land-Rover. The Queen will then have various St. John officials and overseas representatives presented to her and will afterwards take the Salute at the March Past.

Representatives of the St. John Ambulance Brigade Overseas, including a contingent from Malta and representatives from Hong Kong, Singapore and other parts of the Commonwealth will also march past.

There will be no Royal address. Immediately after the March Past has ended, the Queen and the Royal Party will leave.

Special stands will be put up for photographers and Newsreel and Television cameramen; reporters will be placed next to the Royal Dais.

Applications for tickets should be sent in as soon as possible to the Press Officer, Order of St. John, 10 Grosvenor Crescent, London, S.W.1., stating whether the passes are required for reporters or photographers or for messengers.

Your representative and/or photographer will be able to get any further information on the day itself from Mr. Lees or Mrs. Wyndham who will be at the Royal Dais from 2.15 p.m. onwards.
