

## ATHENS PROTESTS CYPRUS HANGINGS

10,000 massed in Omonia Square passed a resolution urged ~~demanded~~ by the Greek Archbishop, demanding that two Cypriots under death-sentence <sup>in Cyprus</sup> should not be hanged. The meeting developed into a riot. In clashes with the police Three people were killed, 124 injured.
