ATHENS PROTESTS CYPRUS HANGINGS

10,000 massed in Omonia Square passed a resolution urged mamandant by the Greek Archbishep, demanding that two in Gpus Cypriots under death-sensence, should not be hanged. The meeting developed into a riot. In clashes with the police Three people were killed, 124 injured.
