| 2 | | Thousands of Africans began to arrive at the Stadium at 1.30 p.m. for the match which was to begin at 5 p.m. we have some shots of their arrival, and purchasing tickets. On this roll we also have two quick shots of Witch Doctors, for and against Stabley. The first one, with feathers, is for Stanley and was invited by the Football Association, and the second one, in black mask, is for the African team. These witch doctors, do not like to be photographed, and there are very short shots of them. Apparently whenever there is a big match on in which white plays against black, Witchdoctors are called in to cast the spell. other shots are close ups of African audience, and general views. |
