Her Majesty was received by the Duke of Gloucester, finite and and and and and and an Senior Colonel, Brigade of Guards, when she went to Wellington Barracks management (where she was almost introduced to the Duke of Edinburgh) to open a Memordal Cloister. Her Majesty's husband was among the Colonels of Guards Regiments whom the Duke of Gloucester presented. The Queen declared the Cloister opened "in honoured memory of officers and men of the Household Brigade who gave their lives in the second world war." In books of remembrance are recorded their names, as having served in the regiments of foot guards and the Household Cavalry. The soldiers commemorated here fought in the Guards, perhaps the most distinguished regiments in the world.
