

PETER COLLINS WINS BELGIAN GRAND PRIX

15 of Europe's best drivers got away to a lightning start at Francorchamps in the Belgian Grand Prix. Early on there was the now usual duel between Stirling Moss and Fangio, but after nearly 80 miles Moss's Maserati lost a wheel.* Only great skill saved him going over into a ravine. He ran back to the pits to take over another Maserati, eventually coming third. But for that wheel he might well have won. He drove his new car at terrific speed.
